

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 1 - A more competitive and smarter Europe

This Priority features Calls for Projects for SMEs, clusters, Smart Specialisation Parks and the private sector, in collaboration with public and academic counterparts. Tender 131.B -Increasing the competitiveness of SMEs in the Northwest Development Region - saw a high uptake with 470 submissions, highlighting the program's private sector appeal.



A **€6.1 million** financing contract has been signed for the creation of a Smart Specialisation Park in the city of Marghita (Bihor county), the third in a series intended to establish a network designed to foster innovative solutions across various sectors, including medical activities, cosmetics, and the agrifood industry. These hubs are expected to draw in highly skilled workers and entrepreneurs, supplying the global market with quality products and fostering economic development within the community.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 3 - A greener Europe involves tenders targeting energy efficiency in housing, public buildings (including heritage sites), and renewable energy in rural areas. It also supports green cities and improved urban green infrastructure. The most active calls were 311.A -Increasing energy efficiency in the region as part of investments in the housing sector (40 projects) and 312.A - Supporting energy efficiency in public buildings, including heritage buildings (39 projects).



The city of Tăuții Măgherăuș has signed a contract worth €1.7 million to create a green area that will provide moments of relaxation for the whole community. With these funds, almost 12,000 square meters of public space will have alleys, bicycle paths, street furniture and public lighting systems. The longterm effect of this project is to environment that create an attractive and accessible to all residents, as well as enhancing the existing natural beauty.

More than 4,200 citizens will have access to these new green spaces by the end of the project, set for June 2026. With this initiative, the city of Tăutii Măgherăuș is contributing to a greener and healthier future for its community.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 4 - A more Greener Europe encompasses tenders aimed at promoting the use of public transport and other environmentally friendly urban mobility solutions. Despite having only two active calls, this priority has garnered significant community interest, with a total of 79 projects submitted. Of these, 46 were submitted for Call 481.B - Increased use of public transport and other forms of environmentally friendly urban mobility (Urban Mobility), while the remaining 23 projects were for Call 481.A - Increased use of public transport and other forms of environmentally friendly urban mobility (Urban Mobility) in County Municipalities.

Priority 4 takes a significant step forward with the signing of 15 crucial contracts. These contracts pave the way for improved urban mobility infrastructure in the benefiting cities.

Gherla will have an urban mobility corridor worth €19.3 million, due to a signed contract within the North-West Regional Programme 2021-2027, which will create an alternative public transportation system that will also protect the environment.

Citizens will have access to a modern public transport, as well as ecofriendly alternatives, such as cycling. Six electric buses will criss-cross the entire city, and this means an increase of citizens using the public transport, by almost a third, from **71,000** to over **92,000 passengers** anually.

Eight kilometers of bicycle lanes will allow 150,000 cyclists every year to have a safer way of transport, and this in turn sets a strong example of eco-friendly urban mobility strategy. Pedestrians have not been forgotten either, with modernization of the public lighting systems, which will make walking more pleasant during the evening.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 5 - A more Connected Europe is targeting both infrastructure and safety. Upgrades to secondary roads, including key TEN-T connections, are a focus. With 4 active tenders, the most significant interest has been seen in Call 521 - Construction/Rehabilitation of Secondary Road Links to the Road Network and TEN-T Nodes, with 6 projects submitted, followed by Call 522.A - Equipment to Increase Traffic Safety, with 5 submitted projects.

Oradea will have a safer traffic due to a funding of almost €18.5 million within the North-West Regional Programme 2021-2027.

The 4 streets that intersect on the DJ797H will be modernized which will allow car and pedestrian traffic to be carried out in a safe manner. The objective is to develop a safe county-wide system in which cars and pedestrians will travel through busy intersections. The proposed solutions will enable the 797H county road to be integrated into the European TEN-T network, as well as into the cross-border county road network, which will bring about positive change in the free movement of goods and people in the county of Bihor.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 6 - A more social and inclusive Europe involves tenders aimed at enhancing educational infrastructure across various levels, from early childhood to university education, and at modernizing school facilities. The most active call is **621.A** - Educational infrastructure at the early education level - pre-school (nurseries) and pre-school (kindergartens), that garnered **23** projects. This is followed by **621.B** - Educational infrastructure for primary and secondary education - theoretical and vocational stream, with **14** submitted projects.

A **€2 million** financing contract was signed, which will provide a modern specialized campus to approximately 200 pupils studying at the dualsystem technological high-school in the village of Cadea, Săcueni (Bihor county).


Thanks to this funding, pupils will have 5 modernized classrooms with interactive whiteboards, workshops for practical activities and dedicated locker-rooms that will transform the educational act into one that meets European standards.


More than 1,200 square meters of workshops will be surrounded by almost 10,000 square meters of green spaces, and the pupils will be provided with dozens of modern equipment and machinery that will make it easier to learn the skills that enable them to specialists in the fields required by the region's technology sector.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 7 - A Europe close to its citizens involves tenders promoting integrated and inclusive development across social, economic, and environmental domains, as well as culture, natural heritage, sustainable tourism, and security in non-urban areas. The most active tender is 714.B - Urban Regeneration and Security of Public Spaces, with 51 submitted projects. Additionally, call for projects 711 -Conservation, Protection, and Sustainable and Competitive Enhancement of Cultural and Historical Heritage, including ensuring and/or improving access to them in urban areas, has garnered 24 submitted projects.

Sângeorz-Băi is getting greener and safer due to a €3 million contract within the North-West Regional Programme 2021-2027. Citizens and thousands of visitors will enjoy the benefits that come from these investments.
