Priority 1 - A more competitive and smarter Europe

This Priority features Calls for Projects for SMEs, clusters, Smart Specialisation Parks and the private sector, in collaboration with public and academic counterparts. Tender 121 -Digitalization of SMEs in the North-West Development Region - saw a high uptake with 477 submissions, highlighting the program's private sector appeal.

A €4 million financing contract has been signed for the creation of a smart specialisation park in the town of **Salonta** (Bihor county), the tenth in a series intended to establish a network designed to foster innovative solutions across various sectors, including medical activities, agri-food cosmetics, and the These industry. hubs are expected to draw in highly skilled workers and entrepreneurs, supplying global market with the quality products and fostering economic development within community.

Submitted Projects

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 3 - A greener Europe involves tenders targeting energy efficiency in housing, public buildings (including heritage sites), and renewable energy in rural areas. It also supports green cities and improved urban green infrastructure. The most active calls were **311.A** -Increasing energy efficiency in the region as part of investments in the housing sector (**49 projects**) and **312.A** - Supporting energy efficiency in public buildings, including heritage buildings (**39 projects**).

Signed contracts



The total budget of the signed contracts € 117.336.024,56

The residents from the city of Şimleu Silvaniei (Sălaj county) will have more parks and green spaces thanks a project with a total budget of **€1.3 million**. The project aims at taking an important step to increase the living standards of its inhabitants by developing almost **9,000 square meters** of land. The inhabitants will have two new modern parks, which include a modern promenade area which will help reduce pollution thanks to the vegetation to be planted.

The project will also implement modern walkways, play areas and street furniture, all designed to meet the needs of the community. A major benefit of the project is the planting of more than 40 trees of local species, which will help reduce pollution and protect biodiversity. The abundant vegetation will help improve air quality and regulate summer temperatures. There will also be clear health benefits for residents. The green space is also designed to collect rainwater to combat flooding and protect the soil in the long term.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects: Priority 4 - A more Greener Europe encompasses tenders aimed at promoting the use of public transport and other environmentally friendly urban mobility solutions. Despite having only two active calls, this priority has garnered significant community interest, with a total of 79 projects submitted. Of these, 46 were submitted for Call 481.B - Increased use of public transport and other forms of environmentally friendly urban mobility (Urban Mobility), while the remaining 28 projects were for Call 481.A - Increased use of other public transport and forms of environmentally friendly urban mobility (Urban Mobility) in County Municipalities.

Priority 4 takes a significant step forward with the signing of **26** crucial contracts. These contracts pave the way for improved urban mobility infrastructure in the benefiting cities.

The town of Sângeorz-Băi (Bistrița-Năsăud county) is taking an important step towards a sustainable transport system. With a total budget of **€13.5** million, the project aims to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and encourage the usage of other forms of transport that will protect the environment.

By building this mobility corridor, the inhabitants will have access to a modern public transport system, that will bring environmentally friendly solutions to encourage frequent use by the community. At the same time, modern cycle lanes will be created, which will support a significant increase in bicycle use, estimated at almost 45% after completion. At the same time, CO2 emissions will decrease by about 15.6%. The corridor will also include green spaces, modern waiting stations, traffic monitoring systems and safe infrastructure for pedestrians and cyclists.

The number of public transport users is expected to double, and the investment will contribute to a better quality of life for residents.





Submitted Projects

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 5 - A more Connected Europe is targeting both infrastructure and safety. Upgrades to secondary roads, including key TEN-T connections, are a focus. With 4 active tenders, the most significant interest has been seen in Call 522.A - Equipment to Increase Traffic Safety, with **8** projects submitted, followed by Call 521 - Construction / Rehabilitation of Secondary Road Links to the Road Network and TEN-T Nodes, with **6** submitted projects.

The County Council of Cluj will invest over €63 million in modernizing their county roads.

For the **10,000** inhabitants that drive on the county roads DJ170B and DJ103K, this project will make the road be up to European standards. For almost **35 km** of the county road, investments will be made, and this will mean that the road will be straightened and widened where necessary, the basic road structures will be rebuilt, and sidewalks or will be widened for access paths pedestrians. 16 bus stations will be built, increasing the safety of the citizens using the public transport. For those driving cars, 8 parking stations will be built in key points, highlighting the increased interest towards road safety.

The long term effect of this infrastructure project is that the number of users of these roads will reach up to 29 million passengerkilometers/year, which demonstrates the need for regional mobility. This aspect is confirmed by the rural areas that will benefit from an increased quality in terms of transportation and safety.

Submitted Projects

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 6 - A more social and inclusive Europe involves tenders aimed at enhancing educational infrastructure across various levels, from early childhood to university education, and at modernizing school facilities. The most active call is **621.A** - Educational infrastructure at the early education level - pre-school (nurseries) and pre-school (kindergartens), that garnered **23** projects. This is followed by **621.B** - Educational infrastructure for primary and secondary education - theoretical and vocational stream, with **14** submitted projects.

The call for projects 623 - Development of educational infrastructure in university education has secured **7** signed contracts, underscoring the academic community's interest in advancing their infrastructure for future development.

More than **850 students** from the village of Florești (Cluj county) will have a new and modern school that is being built through a project with a total value of **€11 million.**

The children will learn in a modern building that will be filled with modern furniture and equipment, and it's intended for pupils in grades 0-IV and also grades V to VIII from the village and the surrounding areas. The new building will include **36** modern classrooms, a multifunctional room, administrative spaces, recreational spaces and a well-equipped library.

In the new school, pupils will not only enjoy excellent learning conditions, but will also have access to an inclusive education that will treat everyone equally. In addition to the special facilities related to education, the project also aims to be energy efficient, which is why all the equipment that will be installed for lighting, heating and operation of the building will be modern to prevent pollution and energy waste. The entire building will be a net zero energy building, or NZEB category, highlighting the need to protect the environment.

Overview of 1622 Submitted Projects Priority 7

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 7 - A Europe close to its citizens involves tenders promoting integrated and inclusive development across social, economic, and environmental domains, as well as culture, natural heritage, sustainable tourism, and security in non-urban areas. The most active tender is **714.B** - Urban Regeneration and Security of Public Spaces, with 51 submitted projects. Additionally, call for projects **711** -Conservation, Protection, and Sustainable and Competitive Enhancement of Cultural and Historical Heritage, including ensuring and/or improving access to them in urban areas, has garnered 24 submitted projects.

The town of Tășnad (Satu Mare county), known for its thermal waters, will benefit from a major transformation through the "Aquapark Transilvania Terme Tășnad" project. The project has a total value of €36.8 million. The investment will generate a major change for local tourism and improve the daily life of the residents.

The new attraction will include outdoor pools, slides, pedestrian walkways, green spaces and modern parking lots. The complex will be built to blend in perfectly with the surrounding nature, offering visitors a pleasant place to relax and have fun. At the same time, the residents will benefit from a place of recreation close to home.

This project brings important benefits for the whole community. It will create new jobs, attract more tourists and bring more money into the local economy. It is estimated that visitor numbers will increase by over **20%** and this will boost local businesses such as restaurants and adjacent services.

With this investment, Tășnad will become not only a modern tourist destination, but also a more attractive and pleasant place for all its inhabitants, when the project will be completed in **August 2029**.
