





Priority 1 - A more competitive and smarter Europe


This Priority features Calls for Projects for SMEs, clusters, Smart Specialisation Parks and the private sector, in collaboration with public and academic counterparts. Tender 121 -Digitalization of SMEs in the North-West Development Region - saw a high uptake with 477 submissions, highlighting the program's private sector appeal.

Under this Priority, 68 contracts have been secured, with 12 pertaining to the Smart Specialisation Parks and the remaining 56 supporting the private sector.



Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 3 - A greener Europe involves tenders targeting energy efficiency in housing, public buildings (including heritage sites), and renewable energy in rural areas. It also supports green cities and improved urban green infrastructure. The most active calls were 311.A - Increasing energy efficiency in the region as part of investments in the housing sector (49 projects) and 312.A - Supporting energy efficiency in public buildings, including heritage buildings (39 projects).





The residents from the city of Simleu Silvaniei (Sălaj county) will have more parks and green spaces thanks a project with a total budget of €1,3 million. The project aims at taking an important step to increase the living standards of its inhabitants by developing almost 9,000 square meters of land. The inhabitants will have two new modern parks, which include a modern promenade area which will help reduce pollution thanks to the vegetation to be planted.

The project will also implement modern walkways, play areas and street furniture, all designed to meet the needs of the community. A major benefit of the project is the planting of more than 40 trees of local species, which will help pollution reduce and biodiversity. The abundant vegetation will help improve air quality and regulate summer temperatures. There will also be clear health benefits for residents. The green space is also designed to collect rainwater to combat flooding and protect the soil in the long term.


Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 4 - A more Greener Europe encompasses tenders aimed at promoting the use of public transport and other environmentally friendly urban mobility solutions. Despite having only two active calls, this priority has garnered significant community interest, with a total of 79 projects submitted. Of these, 46 were submitted for Call 481.B - Increased use of public transport and other forms of environmentally friendly urban mobility (Urban Mobility), while the remaining 32 projects were for Call 481.A - Increased use of other public transport and forms of environmentally friendly urban mobility (Urban Mobility) in County Municipalities.

municipality of Cluj-Napoca accelerating its transition to a sustainable urban mobility system with a major investment of over €26 million, co-financed through European funds. This initiative supports city's commitment achieving a 100% non-polluting public transport fleet by 2028, contributing to cleaner air and a healthier environment.

As part of this project, 31 new electric buses will replace aging diesel-powered vehicles, significantly reducing greenhouse emissions. To ensure seamless operation, the investment also includes the installation of 18 slow-charging stations and 5 fast-charging stations across the city.

With these improvements, public transport in the city will become more attractive and efficient, leading to a decrease in private car use and lower traffic congestion. The transition is expected to result in a substantial reduction of CO2 emissions, directly improving air quality and public health.

This initiative is a key step in the city's longterm strategy to develop a modern, accessible, and environmentally responsible transport network, in line with European sustainability goals. The new electric buses are expected to enter service within two years, offering residents a cleaner, more comfortable, and energy-efficient way to travel.

Priority 5 - A more Connected Europe is targeting both infrastructure and safety. Upgrades to secondary roads, including key TEN-T connections, are a focus. With 4 active tenders, the most significant interest has been seen in Call 522.A - Equipment to Increase Traffic Safety, with 9 projects submitted, followed by Call 521 - Construction / Rehabilitation of Secondary Road Links to the Road Network and TEN-T Nodes, with 6 submitted projects.

Maramures County is taking significant steps to enhance road safety and maintenance by investing in modern equipment designed for year-round infrastructure improvements. With a total budget of over €4,8 million, co-financed through European funds, this initiative aims to ensure safer roads and better traffic conditions, especially during winter months.

The project involves the procurement of specialized equipment to support snow removal, road marking, and vegetation management, well-maintained and ensuring accessible roadways. The investment includes snowplows, anti-skid material spreaders, a road marking machine, and multi-functional vehicles equipped with various attachments for snow-clearing, tree-trimming, roadside cleaning, and ditch maintenance. Additionally, the project will include road repair equipment for layered asphalt repairs.

These measures will improve road conditions across Maramures County, reducing accident increasing traffic Environmentally friendly solutions will also be integrated into road maintenance operations, ensuring the sustainable management of public infrastructure.

The investment aligns with the county's longterm strategy for safer, more resilient roads and will be implemented in coordination with the public administration responsible for managing county road infrastructure. The new equipment is expected to be operational within two years, providing a modern, effective, and sustainable solution for road maintenance and traffic safety.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 6 - A more social and inclusive Europe involves tenders aimed at enhancing educational infrastructure across various levels, from early childhood to university education, and at modernizing school facilities. The most active call is **621.A** - Educational infrastructure at the early education level - pre-school (nurseries) and pre-school (kindergartens), that garnered **23** projects. This is followed by **621.B** - Educational infrastructure for primary and secondary education - theoretical and vocational stream, with **14** submitted projects.

Cluj-Napoca is making a strategic investment in reinforcing educational sector, commitment to high-quality education and sustainable urban development. The city has secured European funding for the construction of a modern secondary school, which will be part of a broader initiative integrating educational, sports, healthcare, and recreational facilities. With works already in progress, the project is scheduled for completion by the end of 2025.

The total investment exceeds €14,6 million, financed through the North-West 2021-2027 Regional Programme, reflecting Cluj-Napoca's long-term strategy to provide accessible, inclusive, and future-ready education facilities. This initiative addresses the growing need for modern school infrastructure in response to demographic expansion, ensuring equal access to education and fostering an inclusive learning environment.


The new educational complex will include 27 classrooms, three state-of-the-art laboratories (covering science and IT), a fully equipped sports hall, a dining hall with kitchen facilities, administrative offices, and essential technical spaces. The campus will also feature a safe and green outdoor area, designed to enhance the learning experience and student well-being. Built with modern and energy-efficient architectural solutions, the school will serve as a model for sustainable educational infrastructure.


Beyond the school itself, the project contributes to the wider urban development strategy, creating an integrated educational hub that incorporates sports and recreational facilities, as well as access to healthcare services. This investment underscores Cluj-Napoca's vision of enhancing education, improving quality of life, and aligning with European sustainability and social inclusion objectives.

Total eligible budget of submitted projects:

Priority 7 - A Europe close to its citizens involves tenders promoting integrated and inclusive development across social, economic, and environmental domains, as well as culture, natural heritage, sustainable tourism, and security in non-urban areas. The most active tender is 714.B - Urban Regeneration and Security of Public Spaces, with 51 submitted projects. Additionally, call for projects 714.A -Conservation, Protection, and Sustainable and Competitive Enhancement of Cultural and Historical Heritage, including ensuring and/or improving access to them in urban areas, has garnered 28 submitted projects.

The "Octavian Goga" Museum Complex, found in the village of Ciucea (Cluj County) will undergo a comprehensive restoration with an investment of €8,5 million, cofinanced through European funds. This initiative will preserve the estate's historical charm while transforming it into a dynamic destination. The renovation includes structural reinforcement, roof restoration, and interior refurbishment, ensuring that each space reflects its original

Visitors will experience an immersive journey through the poet's carefully restored heritage objects, interactive exhibitions, and modern amenities. The mausoleum and surrounding buildings, including the Ady Endre House White House, will rehabilitated, ensuring their long-term conservation.

The project is expected to increase visitor numbers by over 21%, creating new opportunities for cultural tourism and local refurbished theatre will become a cultural pavilion, events, book launches, hosting educational activities.

Scheduled for completion by November 2028, the revitalized complex will blend historical elegance with contemporary cultural experiences, reinforcing its status as a premier heritage site while contributing to the region's economic and cultural growth.
